NOTES

1. **DRILL LOCATION** - Drill will be held on the 2nd deck of Building 235, Fairchild Street, Williow Grove, PA 19044.

2. ATTENDANCE – NSCC Regulations state that you must attend 75% of all scheduled drills. That is four of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be discharged from the NSCC.

3. COURSEWORK – All Cadets are required to complete coursework assignments (Airman, Seaman or Basic Military Requirements). A reminder to those Cadets who have not completed Recruit Training: your advancement to E-2 will be in jeopardy if you do not complete coursework. COURSEWORK IS MANDATORY!

4. INCREASE YOUR KNOWLEDGE – To prepare for the upcoming trainings, I recommend using the Sea Cadet General Knowledge packet handed out to you a few drills back. Try to familiarize yourself with all the General Orders, the Sea Cadet Oath, and the Sailor's Creed. Learning these will benefit you in Recruit Training and future trainings in the program. 5. CADETS REMINDER – In preparation for the summer trainings you will be attending, at Saturday's drill, all cadets are required to bring their Seabag, their Seabag list, and all uniforms, PT gear, etc., that is on the list. Bring what you can; if you are missing certain items, we will look for it during our designated Supply time. All cadets must also bring their dress white uniforms with a garment bag on Saturday's drill. Color Guard members should specially make sure that their uniforms are squared away as we will be rehearsing for the upcoming parade.

6. PARENTS CORNER – This will be the first opportunity for our **Parents Auxiliary Task (PAT) Force** to put together an event! There will be a graduation ceremony for the seniors in the Unit during the June drill. All parents should discuss and plan a party together with munchies, beverages, and all supplies. The Unit will supply tables.

We are looking for parents to sign up as volunteers with the program. If you are interested in sharing your time and talent, please speak with one of our officers.
