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NOTES

1. **DRILL LOCATION** - Drill will be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> deck of Building 235, Fairchild Street, Williw Grove, PA 19044.
2. **ATTENDANCE** – NSCC Regulations state that you must attend 75% of all scheduled drills. That is four of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be discharged from the NSCC.
3. **COURSEWORK** – All Cadets are required to complete coursework assignments (Airman, Seaman or Basic Military Requirements). A reminder to those Cadets who have not completed Recruit Training: your advancement to E-2 will be in jeopardy if you do not complete coursework. **COURSEWORK IS MANDATORY!**
4. **PARENTS MEETING** – There will be a parent meeting on Sunday, June 9, at 1300 hours with the graduation ceremony to follow. All parents should plan to attend.
5. **GRADUATION CEREMONY** – Graduation for our Seniors will follow the Parents Meeting at approximately 1400 hours. There will be a party, provided by our Parents Auxiliary Task (PAT) Force. Please sign up for food and beverages you can bring for the graduation ceremony with the link below.

WE HAVE NO ACCESS TO DRILL SPACES BETWEEN JUNE 9 AND AUGUST DRILL. Therefore, we will be unable to provide any training items after the June drill. Cadets may be refused admittance to training if their seabags are incomplete, and training payments are NOT refundable, so make sure you provide all the information necessary to the officers by Wednesday, May 29 for your cadet’s training(s). NO EXCEPTIONS!
