NOTES

- 1. DRILL LOCATION Drill will be held on the 2nd deck of Building 235, Fairchild Street, Willow Grove, PA 19044.
- **2. ATTENDANCE** NSCC Regulations state that you must attend 75% of all scheduled drills. That is four of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be discharged from the NSCC.
- 3. COURSEWORK All Cadets are required to complete coursework assignments for each promotion within 6 months for Sea Cadets and within 4 months for League Cadets. COURSEWORK IS MANDATORY!
- 3. TRAININGS All Sea Cadets are required to complete at least one training per year. League Cadets are NOT REQUIRED to complete trainings, but it is highly recommended.
- **4. CADETS REMINDER** Please remember to bring your complete dress blue uniform on Saturday/Sunday in a garment bag to wear for inspections. This includes: Covers, an ironed uniform, a white shirt, dress socks, dress shoes, a neckerchief/necktie, appurtenances and patches (SEWN ON AND WORN CORRECTLY), and a belt.
- **5.** CHOW The ANG Mess Hall will be closed during the January drill. Each cadet MUST BRING a brown bag lunch each day.
