## NOTES

- 1. DRILL LOCATION Drill will be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> deck of Building 235, Fairchild Street, Willow Grove, PA 19044.
- 2. ATTENDANCE NSCC Regulations state that you must attend 75% of all scheduled drills. That is four of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be administratively discharged from the NSCC.
- 3. COURSEWORK All Cadets are required to complete coursework assignments for each promotion within 6 months for Sea Cadets and within 4 months for League Cadets. COURSEWORK IS MANDATORY!
- 4. MEMORIAL DAY PARADE <u>ALL CADETS MUST ATTEND</u> the Doylestown Memorial Day Parade. UOD: Sea Cadets – Dress Whites/League Cadets: Summer Dress Uniform. Details on time and place of assembly and dismissal will be distributed after the parade meeting on May 20.
- 5. CADETS ATTENDING RECRUIT TRAINING All cadets who will be attending Recruit Training this summer <u>MUST</u> bring their packed seabags and the seabag list for their specific training to drill on Saturday for seabag inspection.\*
- 6. END OF DRILL YEAR PARTY The June party will be held on SATURDAY, 1400. There are no graduating cadets this year. An email has been sent for parents to sign up to bring goodies.
- 7. FAMILY DAY All Cadets will be participating in the ANG Family Day on Saturday. UOD: Type III, Sleeves rolled up.
- 8. UNIFORMS Sea Cadets: Dress White uniforms will be worn from 05 May. League Cadets: Summer Dress uniform (Short Sleeve White Shirt) will be worn from 05 May
- **9.** CHOW We have been approved to eat in the chow hall on base every drill weekend. The normal cost to eat in the chow hall is \$8.00. I recommend taking advantage of this excellent opportunity to have lunch, which includes a main course, salad, desserts, and drinks. However, bringing your own lunch is also an option.
