### **NOTES**

- 1. OCTOBER DRILL Please read this POM VERY CAREFULLY. There are different sites for each day. Details of meeting places and activities are below.
- 2. MUSTER- Saturday: Fisherman's Lot, Tyler State Park (this is off Rt 332 in Newtown directly across from Spring Garden Mill/Langhorne Player Theater. You do not need to enter the park to reach this site. A map of the park may be found at TylerSP@PA.gov)

**Sunday:** 41 Milbob Drive Warminster, PA 18974 (Dymek Residence)

- 3. **CHOW Saturday:** Cadets should bring a packed lunch. There will be no place to buy lunch. **Sunday:** BBQ Lunch: hamburgers, hot dogs, chips and soda will be supplied. If your cadet has dietary restrictions, he/she should pack a lunch.
- 4. **ACTIVITY DETAILS FOR SUNDAY** There will be 4 stations (approximately 1 hour per station, teams will rotate through the stations)
  - Brakes and Tires: Jacking, jack stands, removing wheels, inspecting tires, types of braking systems and inspecting brakes
  - Underhood and electrical: Checking fluids, Checking Belts, Cooling systems, Checking batteries and charging systems, checking fuses, bulb replacement
  - Engine: Components of an engine and how they work together, basics of tuneups, interior engine inspection
  - Exterior care: Washing, Drying, waxing, Clay bar use, Buffing

The instructors for the stations include 2 professional mechanics and a restoration mechanic,

- 5. ATTENDANCE NSCC Regulations state that you must attend 75% of all scheduled drills. That is four of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to not meet minimum attendance standards, you will be administratively discharged from the NSCC.
- 6. COURSEWORK All Cadets must complete coursework assignments for each promotion within 6 months for Sea Cadets and within 4 months for League Cadets. COURSEWORK IS MANDATORY!
- 7. UNIFORMS Sea Cadets: Dress Blue uniforms will be worn from 01 Oct. League Cadets: Summer Dress uniform (Short Sleeve White Shirt) will be worn all year round.
