NOTES

1. **DRILL LOCATION** - Drill will be held on the 2nd deck of Building 235, Fairchild Street, Willow Grove, PA 19044.
2. **ATTENDANCE** – NSCC Regulations have changed regarding attendance. They now state that you must attend **50% of all scheduled drills**. That is three of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to not meet minimum attendance standards, you may be administratively discharged from the NSCC.
3. **COURSEWORK** – All Cadets must complete coursework assignments for **each promotion** within **6 months for Sea Cadets** and within **4 months for League Cadets**. **COURSEWORK IS MANDATORY!**
4. **PRT** – We will be running a PRT on Saturday. Bring PT gear and be prepared to run a mile in addition to planks and sit ups.
5. **UNIFORM INSPECTION (Saturday/Sunday)** – Winter uniforms and grooming will be inspected. All cadets must bring winter uniforms for inspection. Uniforms will be left on base for annual inspection on Sunday.
6. **GENERAL ORDERS/SEA CADET OATH** – Review orders, the Sea Cadet Oath and Chain of Command prior to drill so that you are prepared for inspection on Sunday
7. **CHOW** – We have been approved to eat in the chow hall on base every drill weekend. The normal cost to eat in the chow hall is \$8.00. I recommend taking advantage of this excellent opportunity to have lunch, which includes a main course, salad, desserts, and drinks. However, bringing your own lunch is also optional.
8. **HYDRATION** – Canteens are the only acceptable water carriers during trainings and drills. Please see supply if you need a canteen and web belt issued.
